Dear Club Secretary / Captain / Competitor

**ALLCOMERS SUMMER POSTAL SHOOT 2024**

I am enclosing entry forms for this year's competition, and would like to invite your members to enter.

**Competition 1.** For Prone .22 rifle. The course of fire is the equivalent of a Double English Match – ie 2 x 60 shots at 50 metres/Yards.

**Competition 2.** For Bench Rest .22 rifle. The course of fire is the equivalent of a Double English Match – ie 2 x 60 shots at 50 metres/Yards.

**Competition 3.** For either .177 or .22 Bench Rest Air Rifle. The course of fire is 120 shots at either 20yds or 25yds (more information regarding targets etc. on the entry form).

**Competition 4.** For .177 Air Pistol. The course of fire is 120 shots at 10mtrs.

**The entry fee for each competition is £6.00, which also includes the handicap element and the competition is now self scoring, so there is no longer the hassle and cost of posting cards.**

Conditions of the competition are as before; cards can be shot individually if you wish throughout the summer, or concurrently with other local or county events, if this is more convenient. Instructions on returning scores in the event of concurrent shooting and local scoring, will be sent out with the stickers. Entries will be accepted up until **Monday 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2024**, with all cards to be shot by **Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2024**.

The "straight shoot" event is over all 12 cards (24 cards for 10mtr air pistol) of the competition, and the "handicap shoot" is over the first six cards only (12 cards for 10mtr air pistol).

**All competitors should note that if you are only able to shoot the first 60 shots, these will nevertheless count for the handicap element of the main competition.**

As in previous years, not only are there cups and glassware to win, but also a 'spot' prize in each competition for the shooter who finishes in 10<sup>th</sup> place !

Stickers and score record sheets will be sent out on receipt of entries, so that the earlier the entry form is returned, the more time there is for shooting the cards.

We hope that you will be able to support our competition; if you have any queries at all, please do not hesitate to contact me for help.
