



Allcomers Summer Postal Shoot 2024

The Bideford T.S.C. Allcomers Summer Postal Shoot is the equivalent of a Double English Match (2 x 60 shots at 50 m/yds for the .22 events & 120 shot course for the air competitors.

NB: If a competitor is only able to complete half the course viz: the first 60 shots: scores should still be returned, and these will be entered into the handicap element of the competition.

The competition is open to all members of NSRA affiliated clubs.

The competition may be shot **at any time** throughout the summer and the cards need not be shot on the same day; you may shoot one card at a time if you wish, provided they are all shot by **Thursday 31st October 2024**

Because we realise there is a limited availability of outdoor ranges, cards may be shot concurrently with other local or county-run events **with their permission**, provided that a responsible scorer is appointed and that the score sheet issued by Bideford T.S.C. is completed and returned.

The trophies are to be held for one year. In addition, each winner and runner-up will receive a piece of engraved Dartington Crystal to keep, and a free entry to next year's Competition. Further prizes of Dartington Crystal will be awarded according to the number of entries received. Also, a "spot prize" will be awarded to the competitor finishing in tenth place in each competition.

Stickers will be issued on receipt of entries.
